

ITEMS ACCEPTED FOR RECYCLING
PLEASE, REMOVE LIDS AND PLACE INTO CORRECT BINS.

(Effective 01-09)

- **Plastics - 1 & 2 BOTTLES ONLY**
(I.E. WATER, SODA, MILK & LAUNDRY DETERGENT BOTTLES)
ALL BOTTLES MUST BE SEPARATED, ALL LIDS, REMOVED & PLACED IN
THE CORRECTLY MARKED CONTAINERS.
- **Glass (Jars & Bottles ONLY) ABSOLUTELY NO LIDS OR CAPS.**
- **Corrugated Cardboard - Must be flattened and (PLACED INTO BALER)**
- **Newspaper, magazines, phonebooks, computer & fax printouts, junk mail, shredded paper MUST BE BAGGED, ECT.**
- **Tin Cans - Rinsed out, flattened and placed into large marked blue container.**
- **Aluminum cans – Rinsed out, flattened and placed into marked blue container.**
- **Automobile Batteries – MUST BE SEALED & NOT LEAKING ACID.**

IF CONTAINERS ARE FULL, PLEASE, NOTIFY THE ATTENDANT

- **USED MOTOR OIL ONLY - NO BRAKE FLUID, POWER STEERING FLUID OR GASOLINE, SOLVENTS, ETC!**
- **USED OIL FILTERS – MUST BE DRAINED & PLACED INTO THE BLACK BARREL marked USED OIL FILTERS.**
- **USED ANTI-FREEZE – MUST BE POURED INTO THE BARREL MARKED USED ANTI-FREEZE.**
- **ALL EMPTY CONTAINERS OF MOTOR OIL & ANTI-FREEZE MUST BE THROWN AWAY IN THE CORRECT TRASH CAN LOCATED BY THE OIL RECYCLING BINS.**

ITEMS NOT ACCEPTED FOR RECYCLING

Chipboard (soda, beer cartons & cereal boxes), Styrofoam, plastic bags, ect.

3, 5, 7 & FLAT PLASTICS (I.E. fruit & deli containers) OR ANY OTHER PLASTICS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED
