Residents of City of Kyle:

Trash pick up days are as follows: Monday – East I-35 (except SOUTHLAKE RANCH, KENSINGTON TRAILS, AMBERWOOD, INDIAN PAINTBRUSH AND BUNTON CREEK - pick up will be on Thursday); Tuesday – West I-35.

We will deliver a 96-gallon cart and 18-gal recycle container for customer use.

We offer a one-time courtesy pick up of all your packaging materials & moving boxes. The boxes need to be flattened, bundled and can't be more than 4 feet long. The boxes need to be in 10-box bundles.

Trash should be out by 7 a.m. or the night before because the routes can change at any time. If you happen to forget or put your trash out late, there is charge of \$35.00 plus fuel surcharge & taxes to re-route the truck to come back & pick up your trash. This may not happen on the same day as your regular pick up.

You can fill your cart and 3-additional 30-gallons bags weighing no more than 20 pounds a piece.

As a reminder, anything near the trash cart will be considered trash.

The following items can be placed in the recycle container:

We can recycle:

Clear and brown glass containers

Aluminum cans, steel cans,

Clear plastic soda bottles, milk jugs and water jugs that are marked with a number 1 or 2

Newspapers and the inserts

Note: We cannot pick up WET paper - See last line below

We cannot recycle:

Light bulbs, aluminum foil, pie plates, food trays, window panes, dishes, Pyrex, green glass, colored plastics, detergent bottles, juice containers, magazines, junk mail, phone books, cardboard, Styrofoam or egg cartons

REMEMBER:

Always Place cart & bin at curb by 7:00 am

Place newspapers at the top of bin

Rinse and remove food residue

All items go in the same bin

The recycle center will not accept WET Newspapers, so newspapers will not be picked up in wet weather.

LANDFILL INFORMATION

Days and Times for Residential dumping are: Monday thru Saturday from 7 am to 7 pm (or dusk)

- ***Directions: Go North on IH 35, exit 223, right on FM 1327, go about 2.9 miles***
