

ORDINANCE 461-2

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KYLE, TEXAS, TO AMEND PARK ORDINANCE #461, ARTICLE III, SECTION 20 POOL RULES, BY ADDING A PROVISION REQUIRING CERTIFICATION FOR ADULT SUPERVISION OF DAY CARES, SUMMER CAMPS AND OTHER AGENCIES AT A CITY AQUATIC FACILITY; AND PROVIDING A FOR RELATED MATTERS.

WHEREAS, the City of Kyle, Texas, owns and operates aquatic facilities and reviews policies, procedures and rules; and

WHEREAS, the Kyle Park Board met and reviewed the proposed certification requirements as proposed in this amendment; and

WHEREAS, the attached amendment would be added to, not replacing, Article III, Section 20 Pool Rules;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KYLE, TEXAS, THAT:

Section 1. Findings. The foregoing recitals are hereby found to be true and correct and are hereby adopted by the City Council and made a part hereof for all purposes as findings of fact.

Section 2. Amendment. The following Certification Requirements would be added to Ordinance #461, Article III, Section 20 Pool Rules:

- **Certification Requirement for Adult Supervision of Day Care, Summer Camps and other Agencies at a City Aquatic Facility**
 1. **A person who supervises children for an agency, day care facility, or camp at a City Aquatic Facility must first obtain the following certifications through a nationally recognized organization(such as American Red Cross or American Heart Association):**
 - (a) **Basic Water Rescue with water module; and**
 - (b) **Child and Adult Cardiac Pulmonary Resuscitation; and**
 - (c) **Standard First Aid.**
 2. **During any time that children under the care of an agency, day care center or camp are present at a City Aquatic Facility, at least two (2) certified adults for the agency, day care center or camp must be present and responsible for the children they are supervising.**

3. A day care center, agency or camp must file copies of the certifications for each adult supervisor with the Kyle Parks and Recreation Department prior to attending and using any City Aquatic Facility.

Section 3. Effective Date. This amendment shall be in force and effect the later of sixty (60) days from date of final passage dated below or March 31, 2006.
