Mr. Lambert,

As you recall, we received a few complaints from the residents within Southlake subdivision regarding Lehman HS students parking in front of the houses. I have visited the Home Owners Association (HOA) and one of the active community members - Maggie Walker. KPD has committed to the Southlake community to attempt to resolve the parking issues. In recent years, students have reportedly parked within the residential neighborhood in order to avoid paying the fees, or possible due to a lack of meeting the legal requirements to operate the vehicle on the roadway (i.e. drivers license, insurance, registration, etc.)

I am meeting with the new school superintendent this week. This item will be one of several that is discussed.

I met with Mrs. Maggie Walker again this morning to remind her that we will have several officers in her neighborhood next week to address the matter. She also provided me with the information that she (and the HOA) gathered a few years ago regarding the same concern.

I have offered to visit with the community during their next HOA meeting, and I offered to host a KPD/Southlake Community meeting as well. The HOA President advised that he would let me know what works best for the community schedule at some point in the future.

We will continue to work on this traffic issue, and I will provide an update within a few weeks.

Reminder - school starts next week. Traffic enforcement and officer presence will be high in and around school zones.
