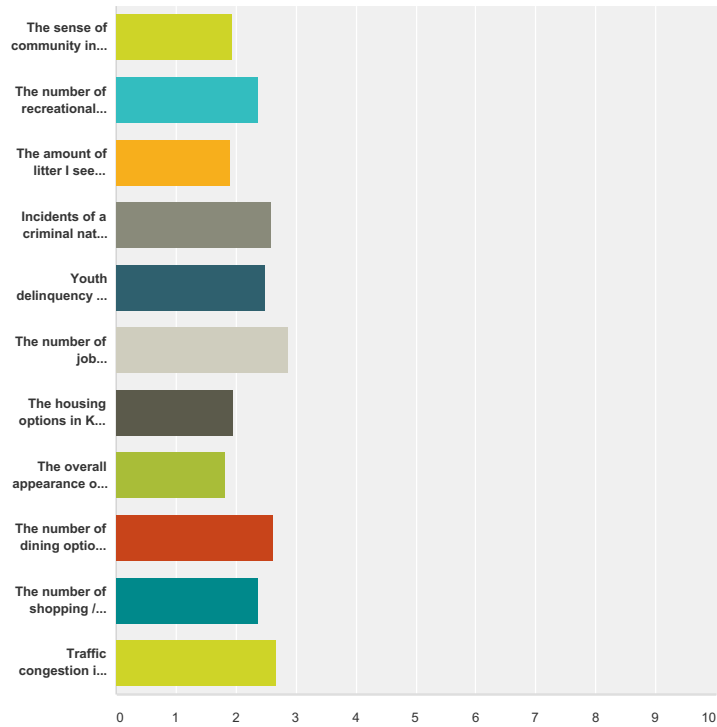

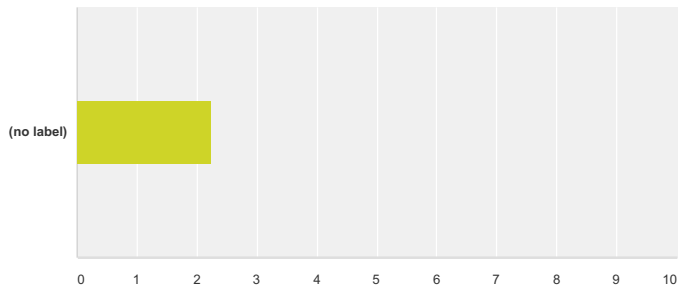

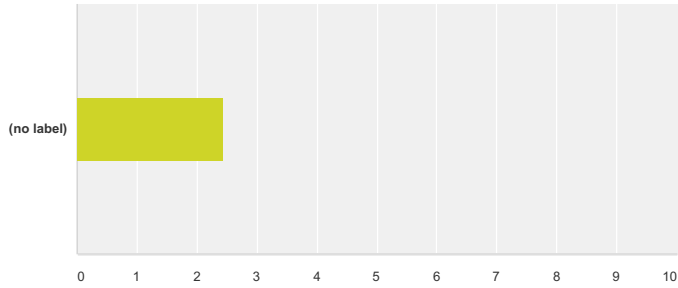

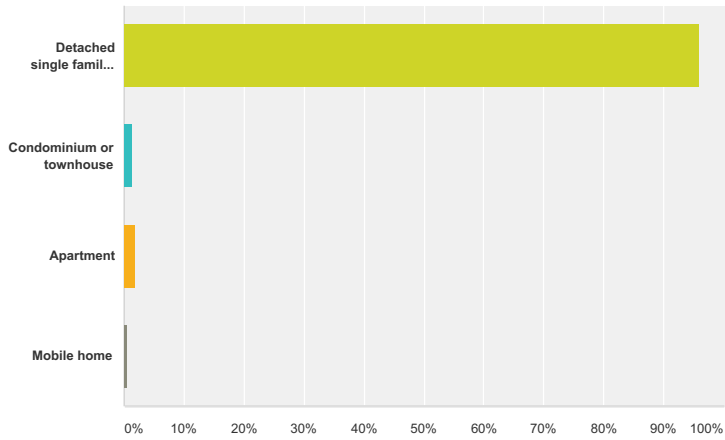

Q16 In which type of housing unit do you live?

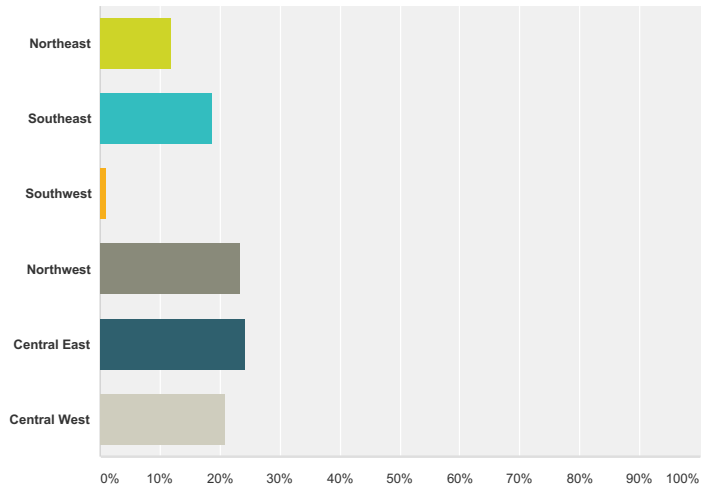

Q17 In what area of Kyle do you reside? Use the map below to help find your area of town (use your best judgment).

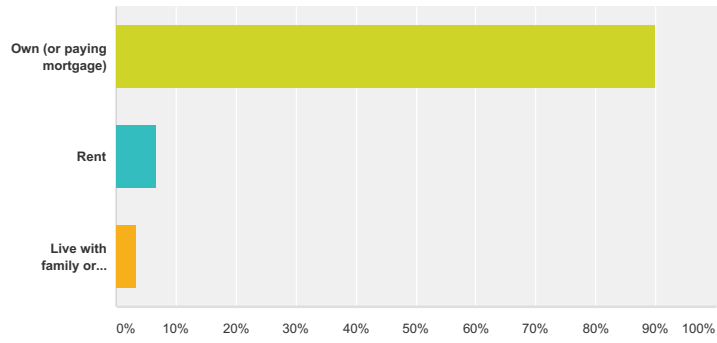

Q18 Do you own or rent your residence?

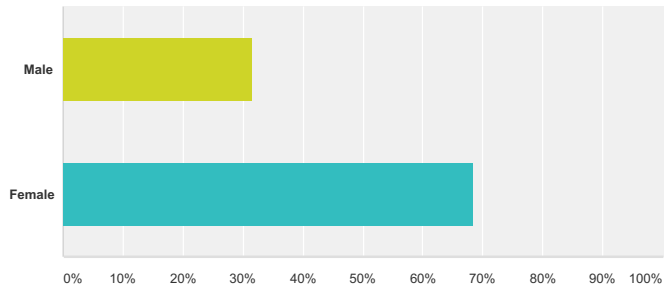

Q19 What is your gender?

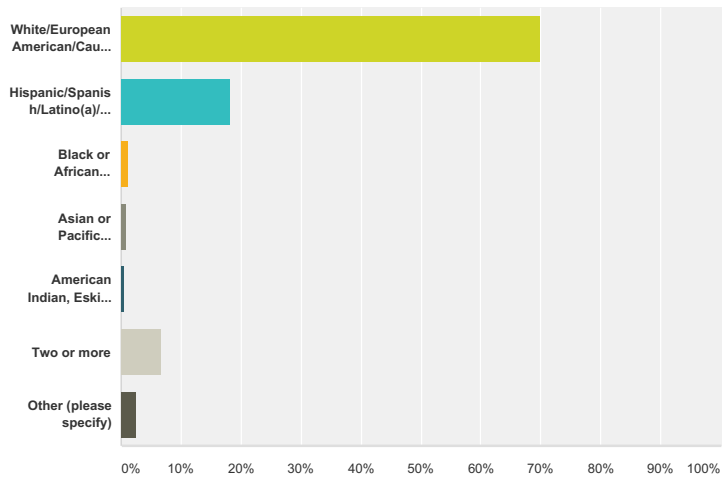

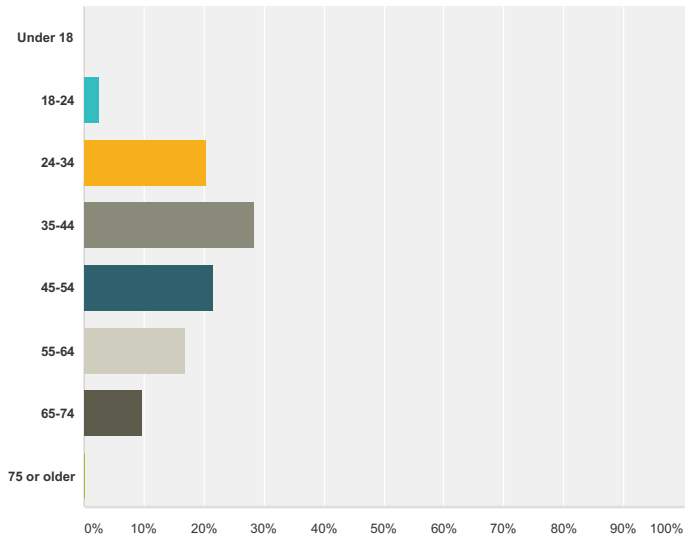
