This is Our Town - Inspection Connection

"Is it hard to build a business in Kyle?" We hear this question every once in a while. So with this edition of 'This is our Town', we bring you behind the scenes insight on working with the City of Kyle to open a business. Once someone decides to open a business in Kyle, the first step (after they create a business marketing plan and develop a budget, though the city doesn't require those!), is to submit an application with the city's Planning Department. For many businesses, that initial process can take about two and a half months to three months. Following the planning and zoning process and approval, the next phase is the building inspection.

During a recent ride along with Kyle's Building Official Mario Perez, it became clear that opening a business in Kyle is a process, but everyone should be working toward the same goal of opening businesses that meet the city's code of ordinances.

"Those codes help ensure the safety of all residents," he said.
