ETHICS COMPLAINT

FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

This matter of an ethics complaint filed by Yvonne Flores-Cale against Travis Mitchell on May 17, 2022, was considered by the City of Kyle Ethics Commission on June 23, 2022 during a public meeting of the Commission. The Commission, after considering the evidence submitted by the complainant and any responses from the accused, voted to dismiss the complaint without prejudice. Pursuant to its duty under the City of Kyle Municipal Code of Ordinances, Sec. 2-278(a), the Commission hereby issues these findings of fact and conclusions of law:

I. Findings of Fact.

The City of Kyle Ethics Commission dismissed the alleged complaints against Scott Sellers which were the basis for the complaint against Mr. Mitchell.

II. Conclusions of Law.

The City of Kyle Ethics Commission concludes that an ethics complaint, reliant on the outcome of a complaint against another individual, must be dismissed if that related complaint is also dismissed.

III. Order.

The Complaint by Yvonne Flores-Cale against Travis Mitchell is hereby dismissed without prejudice. SO ORDERED, this 23rd day of June 2022.
