### **Request for Qualifications for Procurement of Professional Engineering Services for 2023 Pavement Evaluation and Assessment “K22-23.1”**

#### **1.0 Addenda Purpose**

The purpose of this addendum is to modify/clarify sections of the issued RFQ or answer questions received from prospective responders.

#### **2.0 Clarifications and Answers**

The following section, **ANTICIPATED SERVICES**, of the RFQ (page 5 of 7) is hereby clarified as follows:

The following information is added to bullet number one:

*On-system TxDOT facilities will not be evaluated. .*

The following information is added to bullet number four:

*The City of Kyle does not have an active database model at this time for this type of information outside of the GIS system.*

#### **3.0 Emailed Questions and Answers**

Q1: Are covers and back covers also included in the page count?

*No, they are not included in the page count.*

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Q2. For the inventory of infrastructure in right-of-way, what level of accuracy is required?

*We anticipate there will be some levels of discretion with the data collected. The data is not expected to be surveyed but will be used for estimating purposes for future projects.*

Q3. Can the city provide a GIS file (shapefile or geodatabase file) for help in preparation of our response?

*Supporting GIS file for City streets inside Kyle City limits has been added to the RFQ page on the City of Kyle Website. Please refer to the Supporting Documents.*

Q4. Will estimated costs for recommend improvement projects be included in this assessment?

*Yes, we will desire estimates for the project. Due to road improvement budget and rapidly changing market, estimates will probably be more of a broad approach (cost per foot of micro-surface, mill and overlay, etc.)*

Q5. Is this the first time the City will be collecting all the information on signage, street striping, etc.?

*Yes, this data has never been collected before.*

Q6. Is the City looking for the assessment information to be provided in a GIS database file?

*Yes, all of the collected information will need to be provided to the City in a format to be incorporated to the existing GIS database. The City would like to see the information presented in a block by block format.*

Q7. Will information also need to be collected for fire hydrants, valves, and other water/wastewater assets?

*No, this will not be necessary as the City already has all of this information.*
