Windy Hill Street & Drainage Project

- Based on pay estimates, overall project is 65% complete
- Traffic driving on south half of Windy Hill
- Roadbed base work complete on north half of road
- Change Order 4 in progress
- Estimated completion north half Windy Hill mid-July 2021
- Windy Hill traffic switch tentatively planned on July 19, 2021



Windy Hill Street & Drainage Project





- Based on pay estimates, overall project is 84% complete
- Working in front of TDCJ moving south





- Based on pay estimates, overall project is 57% complete
- Forecast rain events will impact construction progress and require continued Saturday workdays
- Treatment pipe, form work, rebar, and concrete placements continues on major treatment units.
- Design team will review the submitted Dewatering Construction Estimate
- No deviations between construction progress and construction schedule
- Expansion complete and on-line in March 2022

- Working from the RR track moving towards Sledge


