Lehman Road

- Based on pay estimates, overall project is 91% complete
- Lehman is open to traffic
- Contractor working on additional items added to contract and preliminary walk through items noted

Burleson Street

- Based on pay estimates, overall project is 83% complete
- Paving and concrete work in progress from Rodriguez to the roundabout
- Illumination and future traffic signal foundation work in progress Selvera to Spring Branch
- Waterline at UP track in service
- Estimated substantial completion August 2020







- Based on pay estimates, overall project is 59% complete
- One crew working on the Post Road lift station
- Second crew working on gravity and reclaimed water lines near Public Works
- Third crew working on bore at Post Road by IH-35

 5.21% complete
- First concrete pour on 08/11 @ 4 am 120 cubic yards of concrete at Headworks
