Lehman Road

- Based on pay estimates, overall project is 42% complete
- Paving from Primrose to FM 150 today; road will remain closed for sidewalk & driveway crews
- <u>Tentative</u> opening of that section could be as early as mid-December
- Overall project expected completion August 2020





Burleson Street

- Based on pay estimates, overall project is 66% complete
- Section from Center to Live Oak is open to local traffic only
- Work continues on the retaining wall at the church
- Detention pond nearing completion
- Crews working from Live Oak to S. of James Adkins





Burleson Street (cont.)

- New traffic routing started Wednesday, October 23rd with Rodriguez and Spring Branch closed
- Utility work continues from Rodriguez to James Adkins
- UPRR track closure will coincide with the city's closure from James Adkins to the Roundabout tentatively scheduled the week of December 9, 2019
- During the closure north of James Adkins, traffic will be allowed to use Burleson up to Star of Texas; however, workers will be present finishing detailed work
- Estimated completion June 2020

Bunton Creek Interceptor


- Overall Project is 96% complete
