



- Coordinating with developers where applicable






### WINDY HILL RD



#### **4-lane minor arterial**



- The Windy Hill Road Improvements project will add capacity from the IH 35 frontage road to Purple Martin Avenue.
- Budgeted cost: \$15.0M

• Part of combined TxDOT AFA








## MARKETPLACE AVE



- This project will connect the northern and southern segments of Marketplace Avenue. The existing segment from FM 1626 to Old Bridge Trail will also be widened to match the new section.
- Budgeted cost: \$11.2M

### **MARKETPLACE AVE**



- Planning to go straight to PS&E after a limited scope to finalize the schematic from the PER phase; part of combined TxDOT AFA
- Agreed in coordination with landowner that Vybe will cross at-grade at Old Bridge Trail, reducing ROW and detention needs

### **PATH FORWARD:**

• Add design of water quality and City-owned utilities (water/sewer) to the scope.






### **KYLE PKWY/LEHMAN RD EXTENSION**



- This project will extend Lehman Rd northeast of Bunton Creek Rd to Dacy Ln. It will also extend Kyle Pkwy from Dacy Ln to this new segment of Lehman Rd.
- Budgeted cost: \$42.3M


### Kyle Pkwy & Lehman Rd: 4-lane minor arterials

KYLE PKWY (© KP01, KP02) LEHMAN RD (© LR01, LR02A, LR02B)


### **KYLE PKWY/LEHMAN RD EXTENSION**



- Planning to go straight to PS&E after a limited scope to finalize the schematic from the PER phase
- Working through potentially significant conflicts with ARWA water line








## **PATH FORWARD:**

- Confirm Alt 2 from PER and eliminate Alt 1 due to roadway configuration and ROW acquisition.
- Consider adding analysis of a traffic signal at Lehman/Bunton Creek due to concerns about the planned roundabout related to pedestrian traffic near the high school.
















#### Center St (off-system): 4-lane minor arterial






- This project will improve Old Stagecoach Rd from RM 150 to Center St (\$28.9M)
- This project will also improve Center St from Old Stagecoach Rd to Veterans Dr. (\$12.3M)

### OLD STAGECOACH RD & CENTER ST (OFF SYSTEM)



- 30% plans were prepared in 2019
- Intersection at far north of the project at RM 150/Veterans Drive will be moved to the Center St (on-system) project.
- Schematic phase will investigate the feasibility of a narrower three-lane section for Center St.









- This project will consist of full reconstruction of Center Street from **Veterans Drive to Main Street.**
- Budgeted cost: \$10.1M

 Coordinating with City staff regarding Vybe alignment (varies between Center St PER, Vybe Trail Plan, and Downtown Master Plan)






## **BUNTON CREEK RD**




- The goal of this project is to straighten out the curves along Bunton Creek Road between Dacy Lane and Goforth Road.
- Budgeted cost: \$28.4M




• Project will be affected by whether a signal or roundabout is installed at Lehman Rd





## **BUNTON CREEK RD**



### **PATH FORWARD:**

 Confirm that Alternative 2 (roundabout at Goforth, recommended in PER and consistent with roundabouts-first policy) is preferred and Alternative 1 (traffic signal at Goforth) can be eliminated.









- This project will extend Seton Parkway from its current right angle just north of the Ascension Seton Hays Hospital to connect with Kohlers Crossing across I-35.
- Budgeted cost: \$66.1M

## **KOHLERS TO SETON**

- Guidance from TxDOT is to divide the project into two:
  - Crossing within I-35 ROW (with TxDOT AFA)
  - New roadway across Caraway tract from I-35 northbound frontage road to Seton Parkway (part of combined TxDOT AFA)

### **PATH FORWARD:**


- Divide the project into two:
  - I-35 crossing
  - From I-35 northbound frontage road to Seton Pkwy
- Eliminate the second alternative included in the Preliminary Engineering Report (PER) to cross I-35 at Bebee instead of at Kohlers.





### **BEBEE RD**



- This project consists of realigning the sharp curves of Bebee Rd between I-35 and Sunlight Blvd and upgrading Bebee Road between I-35 and Goforth Road (CR 157).
- Budgeted cost: \$66.6M


#### **3-lane collector west of Kohlers to Seton**





#### 4-lane minor arterial east of Kohlers to Seton


### **BEBEE RD**



- Roundabout at Kohlers/Bebee is now planned to be in the Bebee project design scope and included in first construction project
- Project will be divided into three segments to have greater construction schedule flexibility
- Part of combined TxDOT AFA









### **PATH FORWARD:**

 Eliminate Alternative 1 from PER that proposed to move the connection to the frontage road farther north.
