The fun takes place 10 a.m.-2 p.m. June 4 at City Square Park in downtown Kyle.

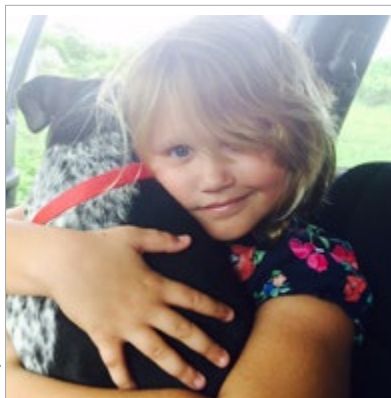

Fun with Quidditch!

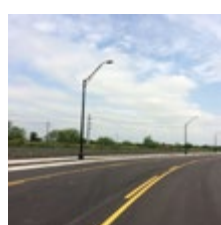
