Mayoral Proclamation

WHEREAS, 6.3 million Texans have experienced some form of sexual assault in their lifetime and

WHEREAS, 2 in 5 women and 1 in 5 men in Texas have been sexually assaulted in their lifetime affecting all races, ages, genders and economic situations; and

WHEREAS, the Hays-Caldwell Women's Center provided direct services to 693 adult victims of sexual assault in Hays and Caldwell Counties last year; and

WHEREAS, the City of Kyle is intolerant of sexual violence in any form and recognizes that education and awareness may prevent sexual assault; and

WHEREAS, efforts to reduce sexual assault can only be successful through citizen involvement, and the safety of the citizens of the City of Kyle depends upon our actions to end sexual assault;

NOW THEREFORE I, Travis Mitchell, by virtue of the authority vested in me as mayor of Kyle, Texas, do hereby proclaim the month of April 2021 as, as

“SEXUAL ASSAULT AWARENESS & PREVENTION MONTH”
