New 101-acre mixed use urban district coming to east Kyle

Commercial real estate company NewQuest will bring a new mixed-use development to east Kyle at Interstate 35 and Bebee Road. The 101-acre development will include 450,000 square feet of retail space with multi-family housing centered around an urban district with green space tied into the City of Kyle's Vybe Trail system. The NewQuest development represents an over \$250 million capital investment in our region and is estimated to bring over 800 jobs to the area. ROAD BOND UPDATES

In November of 2022, City of Kyle voters approved Proposition A. The proposition, which totals \$294 million, provides funding for critical transportation projects that will decrease congestion and improve overall safety and mobility in Kyle.

The public was invited to seven open houses and many public workshops between Oct. 1st, 2022 and Jan. 10th, 2024 to provide input on the projects, and City Council is voting on final designs for the roads at the meeting on Tuesday, Jan. 16th, 2024.

Marketplace Avenue and Kohlers Crossing will be the first roads to begin construction in 2024, with many roads on the east and west side planned for improvements in the near future.
