3. Discussion of matters relating to HCESD No. 5 emergency response services regarding City and ESD function, jurisdiction and authority, interaction, needs, requirements, and long-term planning; including but not limited to matters of finance, facilities and equipment, and contractual matters.
4. Discussion of proposed MOU from Monarch Utilities relating to utility system use by the Kyle Fire Department for fire suppression.
5. Discussion on possible sales and use tax collection by the HCESD No. 5.
6. Adjourn.

*Per Texas Attorney General Opinion No. JC-0169; Open Meeting & Agenda Requirements, Dated January 24, 2000: The permissible responses to a general member communication at the meeting are limited by 551.042, as follows: "SEC.551.042. Inquiry Made at Meeting. (a) If, at a meeting of a government body, a member of the public or of the governmental body inquires about a subject for which notice has not been given as required by the subchapter, the notice provisions of this subchapter, do not apply to:(1) a statement of specific factual information given in response to the inquiry; or (2) a recitation of existing policy in response to the inquiry. (b) Any deliberation of or decision about the subject of the inquiry shall be limited to a proposal to place the subject on the agenda for a subsequent meeting.
