I. Call Meeting to Order

II. Citizen Comment Period with City Council

Mayor Mitchell opened citizen comments at 8:02 a.m. With no one wishing to speak, Mayor Mitchell closed citizen comments at 8:02 a.m.

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III. **Consider and Possible Action**

1. Receive a presentation, hold a discussion, and provide staff direction regarding the City Manager's Proposed Budget for Fiscal Year 2023-2024. ~ Bryan Langley, City Manager

Mayor Mitchell brought forward Item No. 1 for discussion. Mr. Langley opened the presentation. He presented on Key Budget Initiatives and Focus Areas. Mr. Moheet presented Proposed Fund Financials for FY 2023-2024. Mr. Langley spoke about Next Steps.

Mayor Mitchell moved to amend the proposed budget to eliminate Item No. 13 on the five-year CIP Plan, which is the Fire Station Property Acquisition, and to reallocate those dollars to Number 1 Downtown Redevelopment Program. Council Member Flores-Cale seconded the motion. Motion carried 7-0.

Mayor Mitchell moved to amend the five-year CIP Plan to increase the total amount of CIP for Waterleaf Park to \$500,000 and reduce the Downtown Redevelopment Program by the amount required to make that increase. Council Member Flores-Cale seconded the motion. Motion carried 7-0.

2. Approve a Resolution to record City Council's vote to place a proposal on the agenda of a future City Council meeting as an action item to adopt an ad valorem tax rate for tax year 2023 (Fiscal Year 2023-2024) for the City of Kyle; making findings of fact; and providing for related matters. (ROLL CALL VOTE REQUESTED) ~ Bryan Langley, City Manager

Mayor Mitchell brought forward Item No. 2 for discussion.

Mayor Mitchell moved to approve Item No. 2. Council Member Flores-Cale seconded the motion.

Mayor Mitchell requested a roll call vote. Council Member Bradshaw voted aye; Council Member Zuniga voted aye; Mayor Mitchell voted aye; Mayor Pro Tem Tobias voted aye; Council Member Heiser voted aye; Council Member Flores-Cale voted aye; and Council Member Parsley voted aye. Motion carried 7-0.
