I. Call Meeting to Order and Roll Call

Executive session pursuant to Texas Government Code §551.071 and Texas Disciplinary Rules 1.05 to consult with attorneys concerning legal issues related to the acquisition of property located at or near 2400 Dacy Lane from DFLC, Inc., and/or other interested parties; and pursuant to Texas Government Code §551.072 to discuss the possible purchase, exchange, lease, or value of real estate related to same.
- h. Executive session pursuant to Texas Government Code §551.071 and Texas Disciplinary Rules 1.05 to consult with attorneys concerning legal issues related to Project Underground; and pursuant to Texas Government Code §551.087 to discuss and deliberate regarding potential financial or other incentives to business prospect(s) that the City seeks to have locate, stay, or expand in or near the City and with which the City is conducting economic development negotiations related to same.
