I. Call Meeting to Order and Roll Call

Mayor Mitchell called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. Mayor Mitchell asked the city secretary to call roll.

Present were: Mayor Mitchell, Council Member Zuniga, Council Member Harris, Council Member Parsley, and Council Member Tobias. A quorum was present. Council Member Heiser arrived at 6:03 p.m. during Citizen Comment Period. Mayor Pro Tem Rizo was absent for roll call, but entered into Executive Session at 6:03 p.m.

II. Citizen Comment Period with City Council

Mayor Mitchell opened citizen comments at 6:01 p.m.

Rick Coleman was called to speak as registered. He spoke about the six lots being obtained from the Quail Ridge subdivision so Goforth Road can be built and the impact it will have on the drainage. He would like to request that they be a part of the conversation and to see that there is not any negative impact on their land. He stated that no approval has been given to divert or discharge any stormwater onto FM 158's land. He stated that according to the LaSalle MUD District 1 meeting on January 11, 2024, an updated agreement is being worked on. The current agreements in place show a diversion of

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water onto FM 158 Land. He stated that Texas Water Code 11.068 states this as an illegal act. He stated that it is hard to believe that no plan is currently in place for stormwater. He stated that by diverting the stormwater as discussed in the December 15, 2020, City Council meeting the 300 acres of his land is at risk of flooding.

With no one else wishing to speak, Mayor Mitchell closed citizen comments at 6:06 p.m.
