(a) If, at a meeting of a government body, a member of the public or of the governmental body inquires about a subject for which notice has not been given as required by the subchapter, the notice provisions of this subchapter, do not apply to:(1) a statement of specific factual information given in response to the inquiry; or (2) a recitation of existing policy in response to the inquiry. (b) Any deliberation of or decision about the subject of the inquiry shall be limited to a proposal to place the subject on the agenda for a subsequent meeting.

RESOLUTION NO.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KYLE, TEXAS, DECLARING THE RESULTS OF THE RUNOFF ELECTION AND CANVASSING THE ELECTION RETURNS OF THE RUNOFF ELECTION OF MAY 31, 2014, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING A MAYOR OF THE CITY OF KYLE FOR A THREE YEAR TERM; MAKING FINDINGS OF FACT; FINDING AND DETERMINING THAT THE MEETING AT WHICH THIS RESOLUTION WAS PASSED WAS NOTICED AND OPEN TO THE PUBLIC AS REQUIRED BY LAW; AND SETTING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Kyle, Texas (“City”) held a runoff election on May 31, 2014, for the purpose of electing a mayor for a three-year term; and

WHEREAS, the names of the candidates were submitted, the election was held and conducted and the returns thereof were made, all as required by laws of the United States and the State of Texas, including particularly the Texas Election Code, together with all amendments and additions thereto; and

WHEREAS, it was found that the persons herein named received the following votes for said term of office for the office of mayor of the City of Kyle, Texas:

<u>Mayor:</u>	Brad Pickett	<u>285</u>
	Todd Webster	<u>639</u>

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KYLE, TEXAS, THAT:

Section 1. The City declares the canvass of the May 31, 2014 runoff election results official.

Section 2. The City’s official canvass of the May 31, 2014 runoff election elects the following candidate as mayor of the City of Kyle, Texas:

TODD WEBSTER is hereby elected as Mayor.

Section 3. The Kyle City Council hereby finds and determines, as a result of the canvass held on June 3, 2014, that a combined 924 votes were cast during early voting and election day in the runoff election, with 620 early votes cast, as indicated by the poll list for the runoff election held on May 31, 2014.

Section 4. It is hereby declared that the City approves and accepts the results of the runoff election for the position of mayor of the City.

Section 5. If any part or parts of this resolution are found to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court having competent jurisdiction, then such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the remaining parts hereof and such remaining parts shall

remain in full force and effect, and to that extent this resolution is considered severable.

Section 6. It is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this resolution is passed was open to the public as required and that public notice of the time, place, and purpose of said meeting was given as required by the Open Meetings Act, Chapter 551, Local Gov't Code.

Section 7. This resolution will become effective immediately upon its passage by the Kyle City Council.
