Minutes of Meeting held on April 11, 2022

The regularly scheduled meeting of the City of Kyle Public Library Board was held on the second Thursday, April 11, 2022, in the Director's office of the Kyle Public Library, 550 Scott Street, Kyle, TX.

Consent Items: Minutes were reviewed. Motion to approve was made by Morgan Harrell and seconded by Susan Reyna. Minutes were approved unanimously.

New Business:

Director Paul Phelan explained handout: Kyle Public Library Collection Development Policy including the Library Bill of Rights and Freedom to Read Statements. Henry Siller suggested the board take a month to review the document and at the next meeting vote to either reaffirm or modify it. All agreed.



Continued Business:


