## Event Details:

The City of Kyle Parks and Recreation Department will be hosting the first Spook-Tacular Movie at the Lake. This event will be a social distance event that will REQUIRE registration (Limit of 5 per circle). **ALL must be listed on the registration form.** We will require all attend to wear a mask and continue to practice social distancing.

## How will this be a social distance event?

We will require all families to register to attend. We will allow 50 families to register. Each person in your party (circle) must be listed on the registration. We will have hand washing station available

Once registered, you and your family are now signed up and reserved for 1 social distanced circle (see image example). The circle will be 8 feet in diameter. We will mandate your family stays within the circle (NO EXCEPTIONS). We will not reserve spots. It will be a first come first pick for the circle location.

## FAQ?

Will there be restrooms? Yes, we will have port-a-potties available

Where should I park? We will have parking available

Can I register at the event? No, attendance is by registration ONLY

How big is the circle? 8 ft diameter

Am I allowed to bring food and drinks? Yes

Do we have to wear a mask? Yes, you may take off the mask to eat and drink, but any other times the mask must be properly worn.
