

- 1) Do resumes or forms required by purchasing staff count towards the total page count of the Technical Proposal?
 - A. Yes. Pursuant to section 1.1.3 (Sheet Count) and 1.2 et seq. (Technical Proposal Content) found on page 20 of the RFQ, the technical proposal contents are limited to 30 sheets of information.
- 2) The existing 2020 Comprehensive Plan was adopted in 2010 and updated in 2017; What is the reason for a new Comprehensive Plan so soon after 2017 update?
 - A. The 2017 Update was scheduled for completion in 2015. Due to staffing deficiencies, the update wasn't actually completed until the 4th quarter of FY '16-'17. The update is abridged, as a stop-gap until the new edition of the city's Comprehensive Plan could be completed by the end of CY '20.
- 3) Has a budget been set for the study, and if so, what is the budget?
 - A. Budget isn't an integral factor in the consideration of the responses to this RFQ. This is a request for qualifications for completion of a Comprehensive Land Planning document. Section 2.1.3 beginning on page 21 chronicles the criteria for the city's considerations of respondents. Scope of Work and subsequent costs associated with the scope may be negotiated at a later date with the city's finalist candidate(s).
